MONDAY, June 10, 2019

The monthly meeting of the DCRWS Club was held on June 10, 2019 at the Chestnut Village at 6:35 p.m.. Our speaker this evening is Kenny Henning. He is Southwest Regional Liaison for Ohio Secretary of State Frank LaRose. Kenny stated that LaRose is chief elections officer for Ohio. The office processes new businesses and is working on ID theft and cyber security (making voting machines unhackable). There are 11 out of 12 areas in Southwest Ohio region that have changed/improved voting machines. Green County is the only one that has not changed.

Birthdays for June were recognized. The blessing and pledge of allegiance was given.
