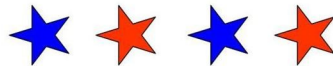
My thanks go to all club members who participated in the last two events (Candidates Forum and "Addiction – Everyone's Enemy"). These were both very successful programs.

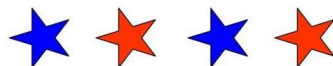
