### Regular Meeting – December 9, 2019

The Darke County Republican Women's Club Regular Monthly Meeting for December was held Monday the 9th 2019 at Chestnut Center/BRC.

Also in attendance was Carl Eubank the CFO from the BRC. Carl was in attendance for the photo op sharing the BRC receipt of the \$200.00 donation from the Republican Women's Club for the use of Chestnut Center for the year 2019.

Wavelene moved to donate \$100.00 to the campaign of Mayor Willman, the motion was seconded and passed. Since this election has passed he will be asked if he can still accept this late contribution.

Barbara Fee moved to send the NFRW the \$10.00 donation they have asked for to help support the Federation Trust Club Achievement. Motion was seconded and passed.

Two Thousand Twenty dues are due now and should be paid before March 1st. The increase is because the NFRW increased the amount we send to them by \$10.00. So the amount due for members under 65 is \$35.00 and the amount due for members over 65 is \$30.00. Associate Members will remain the same at \$25.00. This can be paid at the February meeting or sent to Cindy Pike, Treasurer P.O. Box 45 Greenville OH 45331.

The president announced the Wreaths Across America project will happen on Saturday December 14th. Anyone wanting to help lay the wreaths should be at the Greenville Cemetery at 12:00 noon.

Lyn Bliss collected the 2020 program sheets passed out earlier. This will help plan the programs/speakers for the coming year.
