7:35 p.m. REPUBLICAN MINUTE: The Supreme Court of the United States (SCOTUS) is petitioned to hear over 7,000 cases a year. It typically agrees to hear between 100 and 150 each year. Ex: The Court ruled in favor of the Biden administration when it sought to terminate the "Remain in Mexico" policy; 10/11/22 the justices will take up a challenge to a California law that makes the sale of pork in California contingent on compliance with conditions that virtually no existing commercial farms in the USA meet.
