Our evening speaker, Mayor Jeff Whitaker, was introduced. The mayor started by speaking about the May 7th tornado that hit the Union Cemetery and continued on thru the city park. There is much damage to trees. Thankfully just minor damage to homes. It was noted the city had volunteer help from out of state, Sidney, Ohio, New Madison, Versailles and a 120 man German Baptist crew. Ryan Delk has been excellent help in organizing the tree clean-up. We are blessed but must be patient to see all the clean- up completed. Both Tribute and Zechar funeral homes set up food stations for clean-up workers. Zechar's plan to set up a tree donation effort to replace the many damaged trees. There is a Memorial Day Parade planned for May 26th, starting at the old Marsh building on East Main Street, continuing down Broadway and ending at the cemetery. Warren Davidson will be the speaker Saturday evening. Greenville has been designated # 7 micropolis (a minor city or urban area) out of 10 in the state. Q & A time: If you have a sidewalk issue, contact city planning and zoning. Housing projects, nothing in the works at this time. The Mayor stated, "it is an honor to be the new mayor".
