

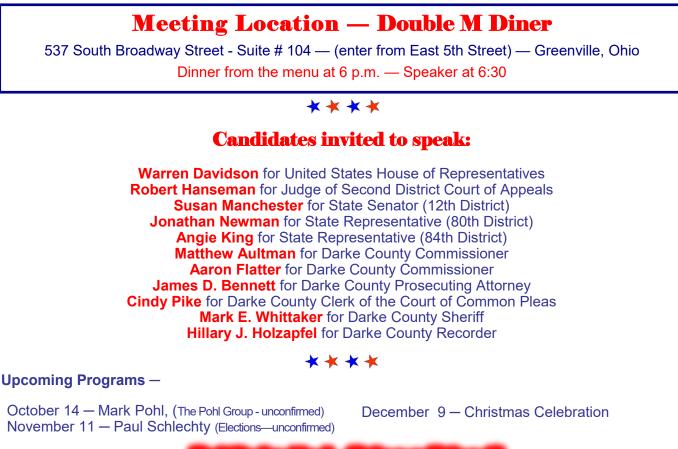
Hello dear ladies (and gentlemen)!
